1935 Margaret Ferguson

Almost certainly built by George Forrester probably about the same time as Georgeville the architecture is similar and it is built on the same feu stretching from High Street to the Links. He owned this house and let it out one of the tenants at one time being Agnes McNeish who was the common law spouse of Harry McNish the carpenter to Shackleton's Antarctic expedition.
